CPR (Class Parent Representative)

Policy

The CPR is one or two parents volunteering to facilitate contact between parents and class teachers. One of the CPRs will be the coordinator and will represent all CPRs during the monthly PTA meetings.

Procedures

Every class teacher will make sure to appoint a CPR for their class. A class can have more than one CPR.

CPR roles and responsibilities

The role of the CPR is to keep parents informed about specific class and school related events. If parents approach a CPR with a complaint/issue, the CPR will not get involved in it, but refer the parent to the class teacher or senior management. The main form of communication is through a class WhatsApp group. To create uniformity in the communication from CPRs to the parents, template WhatsApp messages may be provided by the CPR Coordinator. The CPR WhatsApp group is primarily for school related information (i.e. not for individual party invitations, play dates etc). The CPR is responsible to establish a 'phone tree' that will be used in case of emergencies. The purpose of the phone tree is to reach all parents in the class through WhatsApp or phone and making sure parents have received the message. This phone tree will be tested by the school.

Involvement in activities

The CPR is not an events organiser. The expectation is that the CPRs support the PTA and the school at the various events, by asking parents in their class to volunteer during those events. The PTA and the school will take the lead in the overall organisation. The yearly activities are potluck dinner, movie night, Christmas fair, family fun day, teacher appreciation day etc.
